

Certificate presentation at “FC Hünenberg”

In addition to Laurin Staub’s (FC Menzingen) Athleticum voucher an additional certificate was given out as part of the **health campaign for children’s soccer “Warm clothes for cold sports days - the JC-running shirt “**. Everybody, who purchases a JC-running shirt, is eligible for a **drawing** held yearly, which offers a stay at a **soccer camp** with “MS Sports Camps” at Mario Sager’s.

Lukas Steiner, goalie for the “FC Hünenberg”, was chosen as a winner. He can expect highly qualified coaches, who, in April, will train him well in all areas of soccer for five days at the camp in Steinhausen. MS Sports Camps is the Swiss leader with ten different camps, tennis and unihockey included. The “**FC Hünenberg**” had already **taken part in the health campaign** along with the “**FC Menzingen**” in September and has already accumulated 200 francs in bonuses with minimum effort (informing the members).

Jörg Saabel along with five project partners in Unterägeri (Ägerisport), Baar (Athleticum), Zug (Fischbi’s Herti-Corner), Cham (Börlin Sport) and Küssnacht (Rigi-Sport) take care of advising the members as well as selling to the members, and they all keep a sample collection for fittings and orders. The **collection** is complemented with a cap, gloves and shorts that will **shield** the muscles from hypothermia. This way the **kids** are well protected when playing **sports on cold days** in September, October, March and April. Since the items are **available on short-notice**, there won’t be any shortage of supplies when the cold weather starts. (03/04/12)
